School Leader 2018 Speeches

Strategic Directions

We are in the process of consulting our community about the 2018-2020 School Plan. The plan will have three strategic directions around wellbeing, learning and community building. At the P&C meeting last Tuesday I asked parents for input on the priorities for the plan. Some of the suggestions included increased access to technology, additional support for learning difficulties especially dyslexia, health and wellbeing of students and families, access to early childhood and allied health services including Occupational and Speech therapists. Uniform Update

1. The bottle green with yellow contrast sports shirt will eventually become our daily shirt but will not be introduced until 2019. However, anyone purchasing shirts in 2018 will be given the option of purchasing and wearing the green shirt in 2018. Yellow shirts can still be worn until they need to be replaced.
2. Our new sports shirt—yellow with green contrast will become available at the beginning of 2019. **At this time, the school will purchase one sports shirt to give to each child.**
3. From 2019 Students may begin to wear black shorts and skirts with their daily uniform.
4. White and grey socks can be uniform for both boys and girls.
5. There will be no school dress introduced in 2018.
