Music education is a very important part of early childhood education. Various studies have shown that music helps children learn more effectively. The GRC's aim is to provide high quality Early Childhood Music classes that are engaging, energetic and FUN!

Melodia is an interactive instrument-based program designed around the Early Years Learning Framework of play-based learning. Each week children are taken on a musical journey exploring the core concepts of music through musical games, singing, dancing, fun puppet friends, and a wide range of musical instruments that are cycled through weekly.

Fresh ways of teaching solfege, pitch, rhythm and dynamics techniques all revolve around live music and play which creates a fun and developmentally appropriate music program for the 0-7 year age group.

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## Administering Medicines At School

Any student requiring medication at school will need to have a **Request for the Administration of a Prescribed Medicine** form filled out by their parent/carer prior to staff administering the prescribed medicine. This form must be completed whether the medication is required for a short time only or on an on-going basis for a long-term condition.

Medicines MUST be brought to school sealed in the original packaging/container which clearly shows the prescription which will include:

- The child's name
- The name and strength of the medication
- The prescribed dosage
- How frequently the medicine must be administered and at what time
- Any special storage instructions (such as antibiotics to be refrigerated)
- The name of the doctor who prescribed the medication

If your child requires an Asthma puffer (such as Asmol or Ventolin) you will also need to provide a spacer to the school for your child's personal use.

**Please ensure that your child's doctor completes an Asthma Management Plan, even if your child's asthma is only occasional.** This plan assists us to effectively care for your child during asthmatic episodes.
