Seat belts on buses

Not using a seatbelt, properly adjusted and fastened, where there's one installed could cost you or your parents a fine. Any passenger/students can be fined, and it's you, not the bus driver, who's responsible for making sure you're wearing one.

Do you let your children ride in your car without wearing a seat belt?

In 2017, 37 per cent of people killed in crashes weren't wearing a seatbelt, proof that the consequences can be deadly.

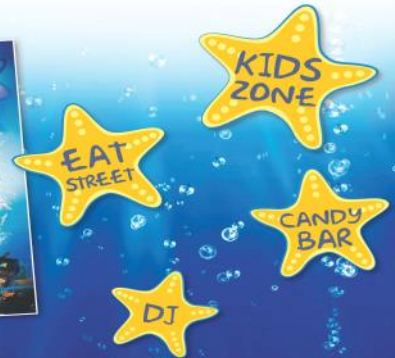
