## Nationally Consistent Collection Of Data

The NCCD is an annual collection of information about Australian school students with disability. The NCCD enables schools, education authorities and governments to better understand the needs of students with disability and how they can be best supported at school. The time for recording this data is coming up later this term.

This data requires that all students who are participating in **additional support programs** within the school be recorded, regardless of whether they have a disability or simply require some short term interventions at school to assist with their learning. **The students are included based on their level of support only. Their names are not entered in final data for the department. The data provided can influence the levels of additional support the school receives in the future.**

If you believe that this may affect your child/children and would prefer not to have them included, please notify the school by the end of week 6 (Friday June 7, 2019). If you have any further questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

The Goulburn Regional Conservatorium's early childhood music classes for family day cares, preschools and child care centres.

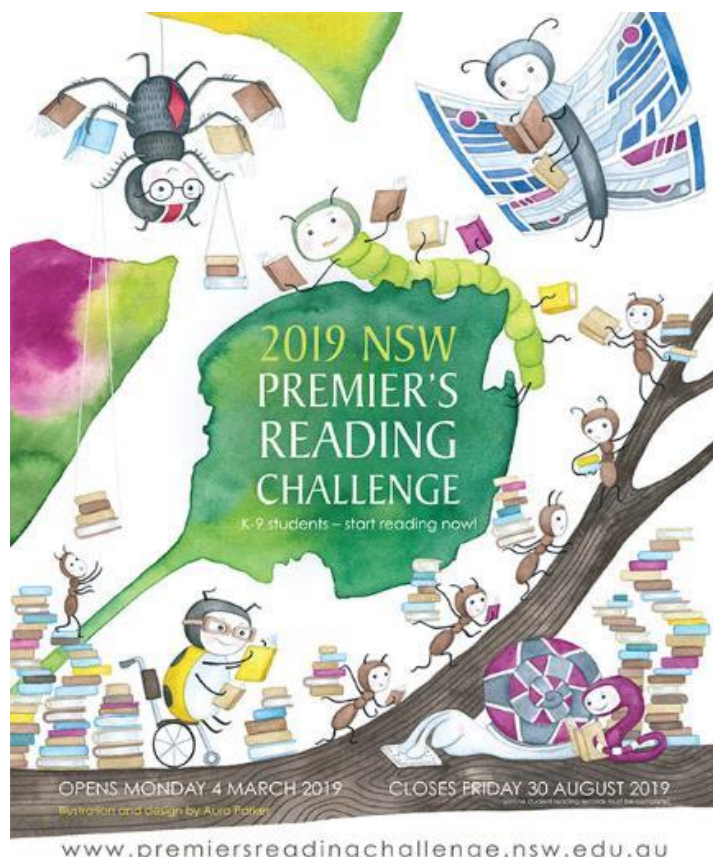
Music education is a very important part of early childhood education. Various studies have shown that music helps children learn more effectively. The GRC's aim is to provide high quality Early Childhood Music classes that are engaging, energetic and FUN!

Melodia is an interactive instrument-based program designed around the Early Years Learning Framework of play-based learning. Each week children are taken on a musical journey exploring the core concepts of music through musical games, singing, dancing, fun puppet friends, and a wide range of musical instruments that are cycled through weekly.

Fresh ways of teaching solfege, pitch, rhythm and dynamics techniques all revolve around live music and play which creates a fun and developmentally appropriate music program for the 0-7 year age group.

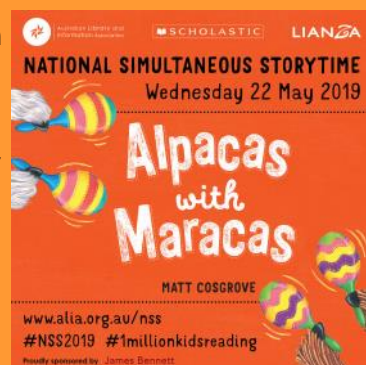
The P&C is an important supportive organisation in our school community and we welcome new members to join and help promote our children's school.
