# What can I do to support my child?

On its own, NAPLAN is not a test that can be studied for and students are not expected to do so.

NAPLAN is just one part of their school program, and by You can support your child by reassuring them that reminding them on the day to simply do their best. ACARA does not recommend excessive preparation for NAPLAN or the use of services by coaching providers. Ensuring students are familiar with using devices, typing on them and navigating through programs is a part of student learning and a requirement of the Australian Curriculum from the first year at school.

are variations in how fast and well a student can type -NAPLAN Online is not a test of keyboard skills. There just as there are variations in how fast and well a student can write by hand. Year 3 students will complete the writing test on paper. Teachers will ensure students are familiar with the types of questions in the tests and will provide appropriate support and guidance.
