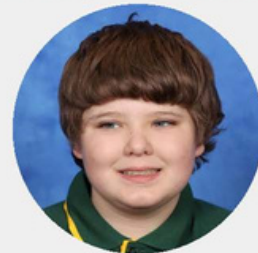
GARDENING CLUB

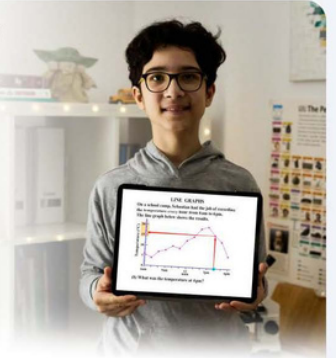
